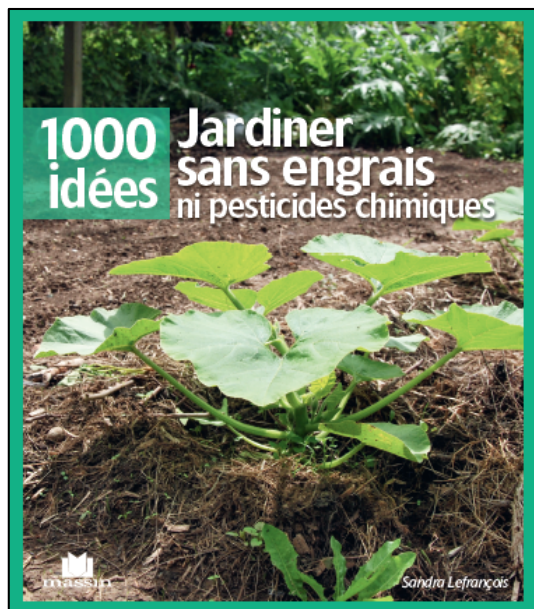


# Gardening without fertiliser or chemical pesticides
