What is an overlock? It is a machine that allows you to cut the material, jab it and oversew it just in one move. It allows you to have perfect result, that would not be possible with a classic sewing machine. Clémentine Lubin explains in this new title how to master this machine throughout 50 lessons and 15 creations to do, with the help of the patterns available at the end of the book.

The creations made are for all levels, from beginners to advanced learners. They will be able to do a pencil-case, a comfort blanket for toddlers, t-shirt, cushions, dresses and leggings, etc. With step by step explanations and detailed schemas, everything is made to explain clearly the use of the overlock to seamstresses, for them to be able to do their own creations.
