Synopsis:

Kirigami is an ancestral Art allying delicacy of the cutting and folding of the paper. In this title the author, Ghylenn Descamps, guides the readers in their apprenticeship of this very fashionable technic. She starts with very simple creations to increase little by little the complexity and difficulty.

24 creations are available in this book, around the following themes: animals, flowers, plants, architecture, typography and geometry. For each of them a pattern is available.

- Introduction on the history of Kirigami, the main principles, the necessary material, how to create volume with simple step by step examples.
- Chapter 1: Projects for very beginners.
- Chapter 2: Projects a little more developed.
- Chapter 3: More complex projects.
